Wider re-opening

The Government announced this week that children in Years 2, 3, 4 & 5 will not be returning to school until September at the earliest. As soon as I have any further information about a return to school for these year groups, I will be in touch. Home Learning information will remain available through the school website, and class teachers are available via Class Dojo. We want to do everything we can to support the children's learning; please get in touch if you need any help.

Key Worker Places

With the current limit of 15 children in any one group, we are fast approaching full capacity for key worker children in Years 2, 3, 4 & 5. In order for us to plan effectively, it is extremely helpful to know when places will be needed with as much notice as possible. Many thanks for this.

Free School Meals

If your financial circumstances have changed as a consequence of the pandemic or otherwise, it may be that your child is now entitled to Free School Meals. This link provides criteria for eligibility and details of how to apply: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-free-school-meals>

Eligibility for Free School Meals is different from Infant/Universal free school meals; please check even if you have a child in Early Years or Key Stage One. For any child eligible for Free School Meals the school receives money every year, which we can use to support your child's education. The total monies we receive has a significant impact on what we can offer your child in school.
