Find out about one of the first toys you played with as a baby. Draw a picture and write a few sentences about it. 2 stickers	Interview your parents or grandparents to find out about the toys/games they played as a child. Which was their favorite and why? 3 stickers	Find out about a popular toy that children play with in another country. What is it? How is it played? Draw a picture of it and write a few sentences. 2 stickers
Set up your own toy shop at home! Give some of your toys price tags, under £1. Write 5 number sentences to show the prices of different toys being added together. 4 stickers	Sort your toys into groups. You can decide how you sort them, e.g. new and old or which material they are made from. Take photos and write a sentence to explain how you grouped them. 3 stickers	Design a poster for a toy. Make it eye catching and include information about the toy. Write a description of the toy, what it does and why people should buy it. 3 stickers
Create a board game and write a short set of instructions on how you play it. 4 stickers	If you could invent a brand-new toy, what would it be? Draw a picture of your invention and add labels to explain the different parts. What makes it special, new or different? 3 stickers	Can you use junk modelling or construction to make your own toy? Can you take a photograph to share with everyone? 3 stickers
Write a short story about your toys coming to life. Think 'Toy Story'! 5 stickers	Make a collage of popular toys. 2 stickers	Research an inventor of a famous toy. Write 5 facts that you have found out. 4 stickers
