Home School Agreement

Our School will:

1. provide a safe, well-ordered and caring environment that encourages children to take a pride in their learning.
2. value each child as an individual
3. have clear aims and learning objectives for all pupils
4. inform parents about what teachers aim to teach the children
5. inform parents of their child's progress at meetings, set targets and explain how best to help your child and provide an annual written report
6. implement any special needs which may be required, to enable the child to succeed happily in their learning
7. set appropriate homework and encourage children to always do their best at their work
8. have a behaviour policy and detailed class rules, expectations, rewards and sanctions
9. inform parents if their child's behaviour causes concern, so that they can discuss this and become involved
10. ensure we are available, by prior arrangement, to discuss a child's progress or parents' concerns
11. provide opportunities for parents to express their opinions on school issues and have their views listened to

Our Parents or Carers will:

1. ensure their child attends school regularly and punctually (8.50am), and notify the school as early as possible on the day of any absence
2. ensure their child attends school well-presented, wearing school uniform and bringing PE kit
3. take an active interest in what their child is learning and doing at school so that the child is supported in developing a pride in their learning
4. support the child with homework and home reading
5. attend parent / child / teacher consultations as arranged
6. support the school's behaviour policy and encourage their child to respect others, the property of others and the school
7. inform the school of any concerns they may have or any family information that is relevant
8. support the school and its events for the benefit of their child and the community

Our children will:

1. show that they are willing to work to the best of their ability and take a pride in their learning
2. complete their homework on time and read regularly at home
3. always behave in a way that enables other children to work and play without interference, disturbance or harm
4. get on with others in the school community
5. look after their own equipment and PE kit and help take care of their classroom and school
6. seek help from an adult to sort out arguments or if they are hurt or unhappy
