This week is national Anti-Bullying Week, and this year's theme is "The Power of Good."

The week will begin with Odd Socks Day on Monday, which celebrates individuality and reminds us that everyone is unique and special. Your child is welcome to wear odd socks to school on this day.

Throughout the week, your child will take part in a range of activities during their PSHE lessons and classroom assemblies. These activities may include:

- Designing a "Kindness Superhero"
- Creating a "Helping Hand" listing trusted people who support them in and out of school
- Art activities linked to Odd Socks Day
- Class discussions and role-play scenarios about kindness and respect

How you can support at home:

Please take some time to have an open conversation with your child about what they should do if they ever feel worried, unsafe, or experience bullying. Remind them that they should always speak to a trusted adult if they feel they are being bullied or witness bullying happening to someone else.

The Anti-Bullying Alliance defines bullying as:

- Repetitive – happens more than once
 - Intentional – done on purpose
 - Causes harm – physical or emotional
- Bullying can occur in person or online.

By working together as a school community, both in school and at home, we can help ensure that every child feels respected, valued, and safe.
