Flu Vaccines

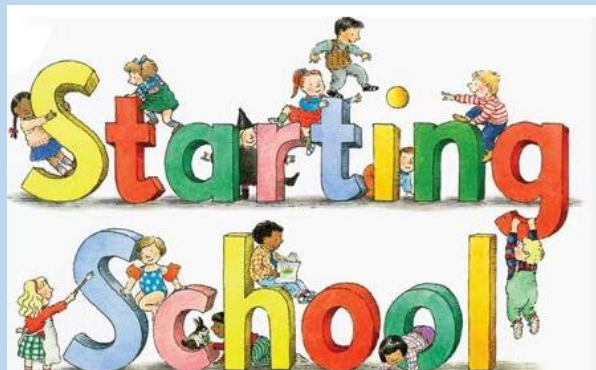
